SATURDAY AND SUNDAY: First 10 minutes upon track re-opening after first break are for workers ONLY

MJC will no longer be accepting blood drawn slips for coggins. The coggins MUST come back negative and be turned into Horse ID. Must be within 365 days of the date the blood was drawn.

If you run without your papers on file in MD, you will not maintain your run date. Horses that have established a date prior to September 6th will keep the established date unless the horse has run out of town in which case the date will be lost.
